



C2 Pro only: With ambient temperature +25°C the flashlight delivers light in Maximum mode for about 6-10 minutes and then the brightness decreases by 35%. After cooling-down (at sufficient voltage level) the brightness increases to the Maximum mode again. This stepping goes cyclically to maintain the user's safety and the flashlight fellivers light without stepping down even in Maximum mode. There are no preset timers for stepping, but real-time active temperature measurements.



- Always follow the instructions from this manual and recommendations on battery usage.

- 2. Apply only the recommended power sources.
 3. Do not reverse battery polarity.
 4. Do not use different power sources together, i.e. old ones with new ones, charged with discharged. Do not use different types of batteries combined as the element with less canciliverance had represent

 6. Do not alm a turned-on flashlight at people's or animals' eyes it can cause temporary blindness.

It is recommended to clean the threads and O-rings off dirt and old grease. Remember that secure protection from water and dust cannot be provided by worn out sealing. And fouling as well as lack of lubricant cause fast wear-out of threads and sealing rings.

To clean the threads do the following:

- 1. Unscrew the tailcap and remove the sealing ring carefully with a toothpick (do not use sharp metal things as they can damage the
- Wipe the sealing ring thoroughly with a soft cloth (or tissue). Do not use solvents. If the sealing ring is worn out or damaged replace it by a new one.

replace it by a new one.

3. Clean the metal threads with a brush using ethanol. Be careful not to allow applied liquid to get inside the flashlight or talicap as it can cause falls in functionality of the flashlight. After cleaning bubicate the thread and the sealing ring with polyalphaolefin-based silica grease, e.g. Nyopel 760G. The application of automotive and other improper grease can cause swelling and damage of the sealing rings.

In case of active operation and exploitation in dusty environments, it is recommended to perform cleaning and lubricating of the parts as often as required, even if it is more than twice a year.

Service and Warranty

Armytek provides free warranty repair for 10 years from the purchase.

Warranty doesn't cover damage caused by:

- 1. Improper usage. 2. Attempts to modify or repair the flashlight by nonqualified specialists.
- Longtime application in chlorinated or polluted water, or other liquids (other than water).
 High temperatures and chemicals' exposure (including the exposure of liquid from defected batteries).
- 5. Usage of low-quality batteries

"C2 Pro: in Max mode stabilization is DiGTAL, in all other modes - FULL.

We recommend to use Sanyo Eneloop AA rechargeable batteries instead of ordinary AA batteries to obtain higher brightness and longer runtimes. We highly recommend NOT to use CR123A batteries as a power source for often and continuous flashlight's operation. Remember that old or low-quality disposal batteries can be damaged under heavy load and explode.

With its help you can easily attach the flashlight to an electric service panel, a bike handlebar, above a car wheel, etc.

The flashlight is ready for operation.

2. Place the batteries with the positive contact (+) facing the head of the flashlight.

3. Acjust the tailcap and tighten it as far as it can go.



The magnet can be taken out of the tailcap. To do this unscrew the small cover at the end of the tailcap and put the magnet out.

Specifying the battery type for correct voltage indication.

Do not specify the type of power source manually unless you use <u>unprotected Li-lon batteries</u> different from those that are stated by default: 1xAA (for A1 Pro) /2xAA (for A2 Pro) /1xCR123A (for C1 Pro) /1x18650 Li-lon (for C2 Pro).



To access the Menu press and hold the switch button (when the flashlight is switched off). It will switch on, go through the all available modes and then switch off again. After switching off, release the button quickly and click it rapidly again. The flashlight will enter the Menu and the LED will flash about 3 times a second.

Now you can specify the battery type:

- 1 click for 1xAA (A1 Pro) / 1xCR123A (C1 Pro) / 1x18650 Li-lon.
- 2 clicks for 2xAA (A2 Pro) / 2xCR123A (C2 Pro).
 3 clicks for 1x14500 Li-lon (A1 Pro) / 1x18350 or RCR123 Li-lon (C1 Pro) / 2xRCR123 Li-lon (C2 Pro).

After the choice is made the light will flash 1, 2 or 3 times to show the battery type chosen.

We recommend NOT to leave power sources inside the flashlight for a long storage period, as butteries (especially, non-rechargeable) can leak for various reasons and damage the inner parts of the flashlight. If you want to keep your flashlight in a stand-by-state with batteries in, use new and quality batteries, store the flashlight in acceptable for batteries operational lementaries and reside the batteries state a least once a month if you have noticed any signs of batteries defects, withdraw them from the flashlight and take out of operation. It is also recommended to replace discharged batteries with new ones before the storage as the chance of leakage is higher with discharged batteries.

[Section2] – Main modes [Section4] – Special modes

The flashlight has 4 Sections of modes: [Section1] – Firefly modes [Section3] – Maximum

<u>Click</u>: To turn on the last used mode (Firefly, Main or Maximum). If the flashlight was turned on in one of the Special modes it will turn on in the last used Main mode.

Press and hold: To turn on Firefly1 mode in [Section 1].

Click: To turn off the flashlight.

 $\frac{Press\ and\ hold}{Press\ and\ hold}: To\ start\ cycling\ through\ the\ modes\ of\ the\ current\ Section.\ In\ Maximum\ modes\ in\ [Section\ 2].$

The same in OFF & ON states:

 $\underline{2\,\text{clicks}}\text{:}\,\text{To turn on the last used Main mode [Section 2]}\text{.}\,\text{Further double clicks}$ will switch modes between the last used modes in [Section 1] and [Section 2].

 $\underline{3 \ clicks} : To turn on the Maximum mode [Section 3].$ 4 clicks: To turn on the last used Special mode [Section 4].

1. General. The flashlight is switched on/off permanently.

2. Tactical. The light turns on for the time the button is being pressed. It will switch on in the last memorized mode (except for the Special modes). This type of operation is useful for short-time lighting and setting signals.

To access the Tactical operation type, unscrew the tailcap to 1/4, press the button and tighten the tailcap again keeping the button pressed. To return to the Ceneral type, unscrew the tailcap to 1/4 and tighten it again.

You have a convenient momentary access to all Modes:

Main. Double click from OFF or ON state turns on the last used Main Mode.

Firefly, Press and hold the button in OFF-state to turn on the Firefly. Press and hold after Firefly activation to start cycling through the Firefly modes: release the button to select one. Firefly modes can be also accessed from the Main mode by a double click.

Maximum. 3 clicks from OFF or ON state turn on the Maximum mode

 $\textbf{Special modes} \ (Strobe / Beacon / Voltage \ Indication). \ 4 \ clicks \ from \ OFF \ or \ ON \ state \ turn \ on \ the \ last \ used \ Special \ mode.$

Cycling through modes. In ON-state press and hold the button in any mode; the modes of the current Section will start switching cyclically. Release the button to select the desired mode. In Maximum mode it starts cycling through the Main modes

Autonemorizing. After switching off the last used Mode is memorized for quick 1-click access at next switching on. If the flashlight was turned on in one of the Special modes it will turn on in the last used Main mode.

Lock-out function. Unscrew the tail cap to 1/4 for the protection from accidental switching on. State indication will be turned off.

Voltage Indication. Shows the battery voltage in percents. The percentage is indicated by flashes. < 100% - 4 flashes < 50% - 3 flashes < 25% - 2 flashes < 10 - 1 flash

Multicolor State Indication. Shows the battery level by short flashes every 5 seconds, C2 Pro has State Indication in OFF state and Firefly modes, which can be helpful to find the flashlight in the dark. Other models don't have it.

Switching Multicolor State Indication ON/OFF (C2 Pro only). It is switched off by default in OFF-state and Firefly modes. To turn on and off: unscrew the tailcap to 1/4, press the button and holding the button pressed - tighten the tailcap and then unscrew it again. The

settings will be memorized even when battery is changed. Warning Indication. In ON-state shows the Eattery level and the temperature inside the flashlight.

Low battery level. When it is <25%, the color LED shows the <u>warning level</u> once a second and the <u>main LED</u> flashes 2 times once a minute. <u>Critical level</u> <5% is color indicated twice a second and light output decreases to Firefly1 and then switched off.

High temperature (C2 Pro only), When it increases to the <u>warning level</u>, the <u>color LED</u> flashes 3 times once in 2 seconds. At <u>critical level</u> the <u>color LED</u> flashes 3 times once a second, the <u>main LED</u> flashes 4 times once and the light output decreases by 35%. In case the temperature doesn't fall the light output decreases to Firefly2. At normal temperature the brightness increases to usual level.
